

Huda Asfour—musician, engineer, educator and social entrepreneur—believes in the necessity of transcending borders in both life and music. Huda is a natural storyteller whose music, through the tenderness of her oud and the lyricism of her compositions, tells stories that challenge taboos and stereotypes. Since the establishment of her first band with Tamer Abu Ghazaleh in 2003, Huda has released two studio albums (2009 and 2018), an original 15 min film score (2012), and has in the last 10 years collaborated with many artists from all around the world spanning, the Arab region, Europe, The United states and China. Huda is also the co-founder of two art initiatives in DC, the DC Palestinian Film and Arts Festival and the Mashriq Maghreb Jam sessions. Beyond her work in music, Huda is also a professor of biomedical engineering and conducts research at the George Washington University.
